NOBLE CAUSEWAY rated off the pace, came around RATIONALEXUBERANCE on the far turn, rallied inside THREE IN THE BAG to take over leaving the far turn and drew clear under pressure. THREE IN THE BAG chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn but couldn't stay with the winner in the drive while just saving the place. NORTHERN GENT reserved early, raced four wide on the far turn and couldn't gain on the winner late while closing to just miss the place. NOLAN'S CAT outrun early, advanced into contention on the far turn, angled out for the drive and couldn't sustain his bid. COME ON CHAS outrun early, passed tired rivals in the drive. LOOKING BEST well placed, raced four wide on the far turn and tired. JIM'S SMOKIN PINOT tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faltered. R. C. INDY was done early and eased in the final eighth. RATIONALEXUBERANCE sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the far turn, faded and was eased in the stretch run. ALEXANDERSRUN stumbled at the start, stopped leaving the far turn and was eased.
