BANDINI ducked in at the start, moved up quickly to set the pace along the inside, then drew off when set down for the drive. VITRUVIAN unhurried early, rallied four wide around the far turn to reach the attending position but couldn't stay with the winner while clearly second best. MAGIC SPEED allowed to settle, passed tired rivals to gain the show. REVERBERATE raced in striking position into the far turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones. INDY STORM failed to menace. KEE KAW was not a factor after being outrun early. BIRD OF PARADISE tracked the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. WAR TEMPO chased the pace into the far turn and gave way. GIGGER well placed early, faltered. HOLE IN THE HEAD tracked the pace three wide into the far turn and faded. MONOPOLY PRICING was through after a half mile. GENERAL JUMBO (GB) was done early and eased in the stretch run.
