YAWANNA TWIST was caught in tight at the start, stalked the pace along the inside, angled out for the stretch run, rallied to catch ASK JOE at the sixteenth pole and edged away. ASK JOE set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then was hard to handle while bearing out several times, steadied and was outfinished. STARSHIP VALOR bumped with SPECTACULAR KID at the start, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. SPECTACULAR KID bumped with STARSHIP VALOR at the start, prompted the pace outside ASK JOE to nearing the stretch, then tired. MOONPORT was not a factor. I KNOW WHY was outrun after bumping with BIKER BOY at the start. BIKER BOY bumped with I KNOW WHY at the start, raced three wide around the turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
