QUEEN'SPLATEKITTEN unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn, rallied along the outside to gain the leader nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away. TWOJOHNSANDAJACK outrun after being steadied in the early going, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a rush to be up for the place. KIPPERS N' EGGS rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly while just being edged for the place. THE BEST GLACIER set the pace along the inside, responded when headed by WAR FOR GUS in the stretch and regained the lead, maintained the advantage to nearing the sixteenth pole, then weakened. PROFESSOR PALMER reserved racing along the inside, steadied repeatedly around the first turn and down the backstretch, eased out to make a run at the leaders racing into the stretch, then gave way. MOONSHINE MULLIN moved up around the first turn to track the pace four wide, rallied to loom a threat in the stretch, then bumped with WAR FOR GUS at the sixteenth pole, checked and failed to recover. SILENT TAP well placed while saving ground, eased out leaving the far turn, then was caught in traffic in the stretch and failed to threaten. DEVIL TRAIN stalked the pace, moved to the inside racing into the far turn while continuing to stalk the leaders into the stretch, then tired. WAR FOR GUS stalked the pace, made a run to gain a brief lead in the stretch, then faltered.
