CAL NATION away alertly, was allowed to chase JACK LONDON off the rail, rallied to gain command from that rival leaving the turn, then drew off under a strong hand ride. JACK LONDON quickly sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to the quarter pole, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. KANAGARO stalked the pace off the rail, then couldn't keep pace with the winner while gaining some ground on the runner-up. JOJO'S MOJO outrun early, saved ground and passed tired rivals. OUR NOBLE HEART stalked the pace three wide around the turn, then tired. PUNSTER saved ground to no avail. FLY SMART was never a factor. OCCELLI rated off the pace, faltered leaving the turn. ALICE'S ALEX was outrun after breaking poorly.
