### Footnotes

ENDER KNIEVEL showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew off while being kept to the task. TIZ YANKEE chased the pace three wide, then drifted out leaving the turn and couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. BIG BLUE SPIRIT (GB) tracked the leaders three wide around the turn, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while up for the show. GREAT CALL tracked the pace four wide around the turn, then tired. CONSERVE chased the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. AWAITED was through after a half mile. MY UNCLE CARDIE prompted the pace off the rail to midway of the turn, then faded.
