STREET GAME rated off the pace, rallied and split rivals inside the eighth pole to gain the lead, then was all out to just last over PLEAD. The latter, reserved off the pace, swung out for the stretch run and rallied to just miss. MAHUBO (SAF) prompted the pace outside REDBOARD, took over from that rival at the quarter pole, maintained his advantage to inside the eighth pole and was outfinished. HAILSTONE well placed in behind the leaders, eased out for the stretch run and didn't do enough late. PRADO DASH stalked the pace three wide, made a run to try MAHUBO leaving the far turn to inside the eighth pole, then weakened. REDBOARD set the pace along the inside, responded when headed by MAHUBO on the far turn, stayed with that rival to past the eighth pole, then gave way. SHALANGAR (IRE) steadied on the first turn, stalked the pace along the rail to nearing the stretch and faltered.
