Footnotes

BRENNNA'S SONG moved to the fore along the inside in the opening stages to dictate the pace on a narrow margin under light reserve, continued in that fashion into the second bend, was roused to gain a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and held safe the late challenge of MOUNTAIN SPRITE to the end under firm encouragement. The latter raced three deep between foes tracking just off the leaders in the opening stages, was eased back from that position to track off the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled to the rail when presented an opening on the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch steadily gaining position inside foes, switched out leaving midstretch while being prompted to challenge the winner and steadily closed the gap late while proving only second best. GREAT CROSS switched off the inside early while being rated off the second flight in the opening half, was prompted to advance while switching out five deep leaving the midway point of the far turn, continued in that path to race widest into the stretch but made some mild progress to the end while earning a share. SECRET FASCINATION angled inwards while moving to terms with the pacesetter racing to the first turn pulling a bit under rating while attending the pace, continued to prompt the leader between foes racing into the far turn, was fanned three wide racing through the stretch and steadily weakened in late stages. PLAYROCKFORME stumbled leaving the gate, was a bit rank under restraint, then forced to steady out of tight quarters nearing the turn, settled last racing to the backstretch and passed some tiring rivals late while never gaining contention. COCOA, caught four wide in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted nearer to the inside approaching the backstretch to track the leaders outside a rival in the second flight, steadily drew into striking distance while being fanned four wide racing into the second bend, continued in that path between foes to upper stretch and gave way. NATURAL BLING angled to the inside in the opening stages tracking just off the leaders as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out three deep just before a half while moving steadily to striking position, briefly disputed the issue between foes in that path racing through the far turn but emptied out racing into upper stretch. SWEET PAOLA, reserved off the flight near the inside in the opening stages, never gained contention.
