Footnotes

PROFOUND was hustled to secure the lead while angling sharply to the rail in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin inside a rival racing through the backstretch, shook clear of that foe racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under strong left handed encouragement. SCORPION AL angled to the inside tracking just off the pacesetter as part of the second flight, saved ground on the far turn, shifted out three wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to challenge but couldn't gain even terms with the winner. HOOPING, caught five wide racing into the first turn tracking the leaders as part of the second flight, shifted nearer to the inside racing into the backstretch to track the leaders outside a rival, was urged to advance three deep between foes on the far turn to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but finished evenly between foes in the closing stages. DISCREET ED, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, swung outside foes on the far turn while being prompted to advance, raced five wide into upper stretch but continued with interest to gain some position. UNDERESTIMATE ME tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the first turn, was eased back avoiding close quarters to track off those foes while switching out on the backstretch, was urged four wide into the second bend to lodge a brief bid but soon flattened out. DRAGON TAIL settled in last along the inside racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. TO DARE IS TO DO, caught a bit wide early while being urged to gain a forward placing, shifted inwards nearing the backstretch while moving to terms with the pacesetter prompting that rival, pressed the issue between foes racing into the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. ROCKITUDE, three deep between foes in the second flight racing to the first turn, exchanged some contact with MAGNIFICENT MOON racing through the first turn, was eased back off the second flight to track off those rivals into the backstretch but soon retreated from contention. MAGNIFICENT MOON, caught four wide between foes

in the second flight racing to the first turn, exchanged bumps with ROCKITUDE on the first turn, was shuffled back early, shifted to the inside on the backstretch but soon dropped out.
