GOLDEN LAD broke readily to secure terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, conceded the lead while switching outside that foe racing into the first turn, maintained striking distance stalking that rival under light rating on the backstretch, steadily moved to challenge for command between foes racing into the far turn, gained a narrow advantage leaving the midway point of the second bend and continued in a protracted skirmish to the wire to narrowly prevail on the wire under stout left handed pressure in a grudging effort while setting a new course record for the distance. SUNS OUT GUNS OUT moved to gain a forward placing three deep while under light rating tracking the leaders within striking distance racing into the backstretch, advanced in tandem with the eventual winner to challenge for command three deep racing into the far turn, continued in a prolonged skirmish for command outside that rival disputing the issue to the end but proved only second best. ATIGUN was rated between foes tracking off the second flight in the opening half, was prompted to advance while shifting out four wide nearing upper stretch but finished evenly in the closing stages. QUICK WIT, reserved between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch while being roused to advance and gained some position while making no real impression. I'M STEPPIN' IT UP was urged to secure the lead outside a rival from the break, shifted to the rail nearing the first turn once gaining a clear advantage, dictated the pace on a clear margin to the second bend but gave way abruptly once headed by the winner. MY ADONIS, pulling a bit against restraint tracking the leaders along the inside just off the second flight racing into the backstretch, was urged to advance racing into the far turn but came up empty nearing upper stretch. DECAF AGAIN was settled last along the inside early and never gained contention. SPEAK LOGISTICS broke slowly and never mounted a serious challenge. DIVA SPIRIT, caught four wide racing into the first turn while prompted to gain a position off the second flight, continued outside foes on the backstretch, raced wide through the far turn steadily losing position, was outdistanced racing into upper stretch but walked off the course under her own power.
