OGILIA (GB) unhurried while saving ground, angled outside the leaders for the drive and rallied to be up late. T. N. T. RED tracked the pacesetter into the stretch, rallied to take over nearing the sixteenth pole and continued on with good courage while being edged to the wire. RIZZI GIRL rated after being steadied leaving the chute, closed to be up for the show while no threat to the top ones. RACING FOR PAHM outran T. N. T. RED for the lead, sprinted to a long lead along the rail racing down the backstretch, then gave way in the final sixteenth. BRIDAL GLOW reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and had no late response. JILL'S ZI ZI well placed in behind the leaders, lacked a rally. ARDENT LOVER saved ground to no avail. MISS DIXIE DREAM showed little.
