PLATINUM HEIGHTS advanced into contention three wide on the turn, rallied to gain a slim lead at the top of the stretch, then drew clear late under urging. EVASIVE vied for the lead along the inside, continued on well to deep stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while just saving the place. PRESENT DANGER unhurried early, angled out leaving the turn and rallied to just miss the place. JOYFUL CHAOS outrun after breaking slowly, was knocked into MAREN APPROVED on the turn, fanned wide entering the stretch and finished willingly. HOLY KATE showed speed between horses, dropped back when caught in tight leaving backstretch, swung out for the stretch run and failed to threaten. PEER vied for the lead from the outside to the top of the stretch and weakened. PRETTY JANE tracked the pace along the inside to past the eighth pole and gave way. AIMER outrun early, was racing four wide when forced to steady in behind rivals on the turn, angled to the inside and failed to menace. MAREN APPROVED unhurried early, was not a factor after being bumped soundly by JOYFUL CHAOS on the turn. MY TIME NOW rated off the pace, angled out on the turn and knocked JOYFUL CHAOS into MAREN APPROVED, then was steadied from tight quarters at the top of the stretch and tired. STORMY SEASON showed speed into the turn and faltered. MAGICAL ILLUSION broke poorly, then steadied in behind HOLY KATE leaving the backstretch, raced four wide on the turn and faded.
