SUN BRIGHTIA stalked the pace, eased outside the leaders entering the stretch, rallied to catch CANDYBEDANDY at the eighth pole and edged away under urging. DANCEWITHASOLDIER unhurried early, made a run three wide around the far turn to reach contention in the stretch but couldn't gain on the winner late while closing to prove second best. MYSTERIEUSE ETOILE rated off the pace, angled out in the stretch and closed to be up for the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. TRINITY MOON outrun early, passed tired rivals. CANDYBEDANDY vied for the lead outside FORMADA, continued on well to inside the eighth pole and tired. D'OHANA (ARG) reserved racing along the rail, was checked when caught in tight in early stretch and failed to recover. FORMADA (ARG) vied for the lead along the inside to nearing the stretch and faltered. PERFECT DESIGN chased the pace along the inside to nearing the stretch and faded.
