STAY FOREVER rated off the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and rallied under pressure to be just up at the wire. VESPERS reserved early, moved into contention three wide on the far turn, rallied to reach even terms for command in deep stretch and continued on gamely while just being edged to the wire. OCEAN DRIVE stalked the pace three wide, rallied to gain a slim lead inside the eighth pole but was outfinished in the closing yards. DELTA PRINCESS reserved in striking position off the pace, didn't do enough late. CELLARS SHIRAZ vied for the lead outside PAGA, continued on well to inside the eighth pole and weakened. PAGA (ARG) vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch and tired. KATZEN was not a factor. FORTY MARINESCA (ARG) trailed.
