**Footnotes**

SILVER WAGON stalked the pace three wide around the turn, came outside the leaders for the stretch run, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and edged away under pressure. VALUE PLUS bumped with RUNS IN THE FAMILY when caught in tight at the start, moved up quickly, split rivals on the turn to gain a slim lead, made the pace to inside the eighth pole, then couldn't stay with the winner continuing on with good courage for the place. KELLY'S LANDING broke to the outside, stalked the pace, was steadied when trapped in behind VALUE PLUS at the eighth pole, then couldn't keep pace with the top ones while up for the show. THATSTHE FACT JACK vied for the lead along the rail into the stretch and tired. OMINOUS rated off the pace, saved ground into the stretch and lacked a late response. EXCITING METRO vied for the lead three wide around the turn, then was steadied when caught in tight at the top of the stretch and faltered. TAINT SO hit the gate at the start nearly unseating his rider, then was not a factor. EL PRADO ROB saved ground to no avail. TACTICAL DELIGHT outrun. RUNS IN THE FAMILY bumped with VALUE PLUS and steadied when caught in tight at the start, then was outrun.
