Footnotes

MARL reserved racing along the rail, was steadied in behind rivals on the first turn, continued in striking position while in close quarters along the rail around the far turn, rallied and slipped through inside SILVER POWER to gain the lead in early stretch, then was fully extended to prevail. ROMAN SILVER outrun after being jammed back at the start, saved ground while advancing around the far turn and into the stretch, was angled outside MARL for racing room inside the eighth pole, then was gaining slowly on that rival at the wire. FIONN unhurried after being bumped hard between rivals at the start, raced between horses into the stretch and closed to be just up for the show. SILVER POWER set the pace along the inside, came out a bit at the top of the stretch leaving room for MARL, then gave way. SHOTEKA stalked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and weakened in the drive. EL GRAN TONY rated off the pace after being steadied soon after the start, lacked a late response. JAY MIKE chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leader on the far turn, then tired in the drive. FOOLISH HONOR failed to menace. SMILE OF SUCCESS bumped soundly with FIONN at the start, tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and faltered. CHIEF BEAR prompted the pace outside SILVER POWER to nearing the stretch, then faded. AUTHORITY RULES was not a factor.

BRAVE APACHE bumped hard with ROMAN SILVER at the start, tracked the leaders four wide to midway of the far turn, then had nothing left.
