QUALITY ROAD away alertly, was taken in hand to stalk the pace outside PAST THE POINT, moved to gain command from that rival midway of the far turn while still in hand, opened a clear lead racing into the stretch, then responded when roused at the eighth pole and increased his margin to the wire. DRY MARTINI allowed to settle, angled to the inside in the stretch, then closed to gain the place while no match for the winner. DELIGHTFUL KISS outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals to be up for the show. MAMBO MEISTER tracked the pace into the stretch and tired. HELSINKI failed to menace. PAST THE POINT outran QUALITY ROAD for the lead into the first turn, was allowed to drift well off the rail leaving the first turn while making the pace, angled back in entering the far turn while maintaining his advantage to midway of the turn, then couldn't stay with QUALITY ROAD and tired in the drive. KISS THE KID rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and faltered. DUKE OF MISCHIEF tracked the leaders along the inside into the far turn, then faded. DUBAI GOLD was through early.
