Footnotes

EAST TO WEST well handled while making the pace along the rail into the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and drew clear. SUNSHINE RAMBLER chased the pace, made a run at the winner on the far turn but couldn't match strides with that rival in the drive while holding the place. CROSS VILLAGE bumped by MZ'S DON ZULON on the first turn, stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch but couldn't stay with the winner and was outgamed for the place. GONE STRAIGHT reserved racing along the inside, advanced into contention around the far turn, eased out for the drive and had no late response. GOLDEN ONE unhurried after being steadied when he bumped with KARMANOS at the start, saved ground around the far turn and passed tired

rivals. KNACK allowed to settle, saved ground and improved his position without threatening. LE ROYALE failed to menace. MZ'S DON ZULON well placed after being steadied when she bumped with CROSS VILLAGE on the first turn, advanced to loom a threat leaving the far turn, then tired. ACTOR'S GROOVE was outrun after being caught in tight at the start. KARMANOS was no factor after bumping with GOLDEN ONE at the start. MO BLUES was through after a half mile. SOUTHERN GLITTER stalked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faded.
