Footnotes

BY SPOT (BRZ) chased the pace three wide, moved up to gain a slim lead entering the stretch, responded when challenged by CUBA, then duelled with and edged that rival to the wire. CUBA steadied in behind rivals on the backstretch, rallied four wide around the turn to reach even terms for command in early stretch, then duelled with BY SPOT and continued on gamely while unable to get by that rival. EVEN RAISE stalked the pace, made a run between rivals to reach even terms for command in midstretch, then weakened. TOP ECHELON unhurried early, advanced into contention around the turn but had no response when asked. MYROSLAW pressed the pace outside SMASHIN THRU, gained a slim lead on the turn, made the pace to nearing the stretch, then tired. LUNAR FLEET chased the pace, was steadied when caught in behind SMASHIN THRU nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. B B'S CONCORDE turned in a dull effort. SMASHIN THRU set the pace under pressure along the inside to midway of the turn, then faded.
