**Footnotes**

COOKS FOREST reserved along the inside, angled four wide just past midway of the turn, rallied to engage PERJURY at the top of the stretch, then dueled with that rival to the wire and prevailed. PERJURY chased the pace three wide, moved to gain the advantage at the quarter pole, responded when challenged by COOKS FOREST at the top of the stretch, then dueled with that one to the wire and just missed. VAPOR TRACE allowed to settle, saved ground around the turn, swung wide for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. ABOVE THE DRAMA pressed the pace between horses to nearing the stretch, then gave way. SATURDAY HERO tracked the pace around the turn and tired. RIGGAN set the pace under pressure along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. CONWAY CANDY was not a factor. STINKING CREEK chased the pace three wide into the turn, then had nothing left. TOP BUSINESS was done early. ROCKY START raced four wide and faded.
