GOLDEN MYSTERY showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then drew away when asked. SUPER SLASH chased the pace along the rail into the stretch but was no match for the winner while gaining the place. DATTT ECHO reserved early, rallied three wide around the turn to loom a threat, then gave way in the drive. CHISTOSA stalked the pace three wide to midway of the turn and tired. FILM CHARM outrun early, raced four wide around the turn and failed to menace. GALABELLA steadied when she bumped with GIBSON CRYSTAL at the start, saved ground around the turn and faltered. GIBSON CRYSTAL rated off the pace after bumping with GALABELLA in the early going, faded leaving the turn. INDY'S ALEXANDRA was through after a half mile. EMBUR'S SONG chased the pace to midway of the turn, then had nothing left.
