SHOCK'EMAGAIN showed speed off the rail into the stretch, then was all out to prevail. HAVERHILL chased the pace three wide into the stretch but didn't do enough late. SPIN ZONE tracked the pace into the stretch and closed with a mild response. WHARTON reserved along the inside, steadied to avoid running up on NEVADA KID soon after entering the turn, angled out and closed ground late without really threatening. WON FAST BULLET failed to menace. NEVADA KID pressed the pace along the rail into the turn, then tired. ECABRONI hard to load, broke slowly and trailed.
