Footnotes

MEDAGLIA D'ORO showed speed inside PREDAWN RAID, was eased back off the lead when caught in tight inside that rival on the first turn, stalked the pace, rallied to gain command midway of the far turn, then drew away through the stretch while being ridden out. SEATTLE FITZ (ARG) reserved off the pace, angled four wide on the far turn and closed to prove second best while unable to stay with the winner. FUNNY CIDE taken in hand to track the pace three wide, made a run to loom a threat midway of the far turn, then tired in the drive. PUZZLEMENT unhurried early, passed tired rivals without threatening. THE JUDGE SEZ WHO allowed to settle, was never a factor. COUNTRY BE GOLD was outrun. PREDAWN RAID showed speed outside MEDAGLIA D'ORO, angled over to the inside when that rival took back leaving the first turn, made the pace along the inside, then was bumped from behind by BOWMAN'S BAND midway of the far turn, steadied and faltered. BOWMAN'S BAND rated off the pace, was attempting to rally along the rail when he bumped soundly with PREDAWN RAID on the far turn, then clipped heels, stumbled and faded. There was a stewards inquiry into the incident on the far turn. No action was taken.
