PERSONAL GOOD raced with the pace three wide, moved to take over midway of the turn and opened a clear lead, then was all out to last over JUMPONTHEBANDWAGON. The latter, off slowly, raced three wide around the turn, then rallied to just miss. MAJOR KEVIN unhurried after ducking in at the start, angled out on the turn and finished willingly for the show. HURRICANE HEAT chased the pace around the turn and tired. B L'S TSUMANI was no factor after being steadied in the chute. CROSS THE ATLANTIC vied for the lead between horses into the turn and faltered. BRIMMING vied for the lead along the rail into the turn, then faded.
