Footnotes

ANASHEED FLASH bumped with MR. O'TOOLE at the start, chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn, then drew off under urging. SATURN FIVE chased the pace along the inside, eased out to make a run at the winner on the far turn but couldn't match strides with that rival while clearly best of the rest. BARNSTORMING well placed into the far turn, couldn't keep pace with the top ones. EL SIMON failed to menace. JERSEY JUMP tracked the pace, advanced three wide around the far turn to loom a threat, then tired in the drive. WILLIAMSBURG was not a factor. MR. O'TOOLE bumped with ANASHEED FLASH at the start, set the pace into the far turn and faltered. DANZIG DEL RAY was outrun. ANKIMO was done early and eased in the stretch run.
