Footnotes

HARIOLUS (BRZ) outrun after bobbling at the start, angled wide in the stretch for racing room, then rallied to be up in time. LIVE IN JOY rated off the pace after being steadied in traffic entering the first turn, angled out in the stretch, then rallied to gain the lead in deep stretch but couldn't resist the winner in the final strides. PICOU steadied in behind rivals entering the first turn, stalked the pace, eased out leaving the far turn, rallied to gain the lead nearing the eighth pole, then weakened late. FLAMIN' HOT allowed to settle after breaking slowly, angled out for the stretch run and finished willingly to just miss the show. HUGO LIGHT set the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. LET'S DO IT reserved off the pace after breaking slowly, made a run four wide around the far turn to reach contention in the stretch, then tired. JAKESAM steadied in behind HUGO LIGHT entering the first turn, chased that rival off the rail into the stretch, then faltered. GO JOE GO steadied entering the first turn and again on the first turn, saved ground while advancing into contention around the far turn, then dropped back in the final eighth. ALMORADI (IRE) off slowly, raced four wide and was not a factor. MILLENNIUM LAKES tracked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faded. AVIE'S PEGASUS chased the pace three wide into the far turn and had nothing left.
