RUNAWAY JIM chased the pace three wide into the stretch, then rallied to be just up at the wire. SUGAR RYAN set the pace along the inside, came out a bit for the stretch run while maintaining his advantage, then just failed to last. DANGEROUS LAD outrun after being checked when he lunged at the start,

saved ground into the stretch, angled out for racing room and closed well to just miss catching the top ones. JUPITER stalked the pace along the rail, was steadied to avoid running up on the SUGAR RYAN entering the far turn, rallied and got through inside that rival in the stretch but couldn't gain late. PUREST FORM chased the pace off the rail, made a run to reach near even terms for command in the stretch but was outfinished. NOBLE DOSS rated off the pace, angled out leaving the far turn, made a run to loom a threat in midstretch but couldn't sustain his bid. STAY RED outrun after being pinched back soon after the start, closed ground late without threatening. GUNMAN reserved off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally. VAN CITRA failed to menace. SMOKING THE FIELD raced three wide and tired. DIDN'T TAKE IT tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and faltered. SCAVEZZATO raced four wide and faded.
