**Footnotes**

THEROS moved readily to the fore in the opening stages to dictate the pace on a narrow margin along the rail, maintained that advantage into the second bend, forged clear under prompting racing past midstretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. IRONICUS broke a step slowly, was settled last racing to the backstretch, shifted outside foes commencing a steady advance on the far turn, was caught five wide approaching upper stretch but continued with interest outside rivals to close the gap to the end while prevailing for the place honors. CAMDEN STREET gained terms with the eventual winner attending that rival's pace in the opening half, pressed the issue between foes racing through the far turn but weakened leaving midstretch. MORNING CALM settled into stride off the inside in early stages, angled to the inside on the far turn, gathered momentum racing into upper stretch while shifting out bumping COPA DEL REY, angled five wide in the lane and continued to make mild progress to the end. DROVER ROAD tracked off the second flight near the inside early, saved ground gaining some position inside foes entering upper stretch but had no late bid. NOWHERE TO RUN settled off the second flight outside foes in early stages, was urged to lodge a brief bid three wide between foes racing into the far turn but soon came up empty. SNIPER (GB), in touch with the first flight three deep in the opening stages, was eased off those foes while angling to the rail to track just off those foes to the second bend but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. COPA DEL REY gained a position outside a rival in the second flight racing into the backstretch, was urged to advance while being caught four wide racing into the far turn, came up empty nearing upper stretch, then was bumped entering the lane while quickly dropping into last.
