**Footnotes**

CODIFY set the pace racing off the rail, responded when challenged on both sides racing into the stretch and continued on determinedly to prevail. FORTUNATE PASS, reserved off the pace, made a bid four wide around the turn to reach the leaders entering the stretch and continued on gamely to the wire. SHES A SHOE IN showed early speed, dropped back around the turn and into the stretch, then came on again to outfinish the others. ALLEN'S PRIDE, well placed, drew even along the rail racing into the stretch and gave way late. CANNON WHIRL, outrun early, raced five wide on the turn and rallied mildly. MS. ARLA failed to menace. TOP MISS lacked a rally. FLY SILVER FLY tired from good position. SISTER NENA was no factor. PRINCESS MAGGIE, in tight at the start, was outrun while six wide around the turn. LOVEY LOVEY LOVEY showed early speed, steadied between rivals on the turn and faded. GERRY'S BACKDRAFT was through early.
