MISS LINDA (ARG) made the pace off the rail into the stretch, then drew away under a strong hand ride. FOREST SECRETS stalked the pace three wide into the stretch, then was no match for the winner while proving second best. TAP DANCE tracked the leaders four wide into the stretch and weakened. SEARCH PARTY allowed to settle, came between horses on the far turn and passed tired rivals. SOUND OF THE WEST unhurried early, failed to menace while improving her position. COOLBYTHEPOOL was never a factor. GULCH LEGACY raced in striking position into the stretch and faltered. HAPPILY UNBRIDLED was outrun. DE BERTIE outrun early, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. CASTLEBROOK saved ground and faded. EXTEND prompted the pace along the rail into the far turn and gave way. SARA'S SUCCESS raced three wide and was through after a half mile.
