ALLAMERICAN BERTIE outran SMALL PROMISES for the lead around the first turn, made the pace off the rail into the stretch, then increased her margin to the wire under urging. SMALL PROMISES chased the winner along the rail into the stretch, then was no match for that rival while just saving the place. REDOUBLED MISS rated in striking position racing off the rail, eased out for the stretch run and closed to just miss the place. TUFF CHICK outrun early, saved ground and passed tired rivals without threatening. MYSTIC LADY tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. SOFTLY failed to menace. VESPERS reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. HAPPILY UNBRIDLED chased the pace into the stretch and tired. TONIGHT'S WAGER unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to be a factor. STORMY FROLIC steadied from tight quarters racing into the first turn and was outrun. SARA'S SUCCESS was through early.
