GOTTCHA GOLD rated off the pace, steadied in traffic on the turn, swung out for the stretch run, rallied to catch FLEETING LIGHT inside the sixteenth pole and won going away. FLEETING LIGHT raced with the pace four wide, moved to take over at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead but couldn't hold off the winner late. HONEST EXPECTATION vied for the lead three wide around the turn and tired. ARTILLERY EXCHANGE stumbled at the start, moved up vied for the lead along the rail to nearing the stretch, then gave way. HIGH CHATEAU steadied from close quarters at the start, moved up to vie for the lead between horses to past the quarter pole, then faltered. BASH raced three wide and was through early. BALSERO trailed after being checked at the start.
