Footnotes

KNOCK ROCK pressed the pace outside BACK IN FLORIDA, took over from that rival on the backstretch and eased to the inside, drew off racing into the stretch, then maintained his advantage to the wire under pressure. SOUP A' FLEET bumped with MOONSTOCK entering the first turn, chased the winner off the rail down the backstretch and around the far turn but was no match for that rival while holding the place. TIZAWONDERFULLIFE reserved early, finished willingly and was gaining on the runner-up while no threat to the winner. MAJESTIC MAN bumped and steadied between rivals entering the first turn, was attempting to move into contention when checked in traffic on the far turn, then passed tired rivals. SOLICITATION rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and tired. SATURNUS off slowly, was no factor while racing four wide. POLITICAL FEVER was outrun. MOONSTOCK pinched back entering the first turn, saved ground and was through after a half mile. FINANCIAL PATHWAY was never close. ROBERT THE BRUCE showed little. MORNIN BREW tracked the leaders for a half mile and faltered. BACK IN FLORIDA bumped with MAJESTIC MAN entering the first turn, showed brief speed along the rail and faded.
