TARPY'S SURPRISE, in touch prompting a rival's pace between foes racing into the backstretch, continued with a steady response to contest the issue into the far turn, forged clear then shifted to the inside racing into upper stretch and held sway on a commanding margin while being kept to firm encouragement. CARY STREET angled to the inside racing to the first turn while being prompted to gain a position in the second flight, came around a tiring rival leaving the far turn but continued with interest nearest the rail late to prove best off the others. FAST FALCON tracked off the second flight under rating near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide on the far turn while moving to challenge the first flight nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. FARMERS MARKET settled into stride out of striking distance a bit off the inside, steadily gathered momentum splitting foes leaving the far turn, angled five wide in upper stretch and continued to gain some position in an even effort. WABBAJACK shifted off the inside early tracking just off the first flight, continued between foes into the second bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MY NAME IS MICHAEL, forwardly placed three deep racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes in that path racing into the far turn and emptied out abruptly racing into upper stretch. ISUTALKINTOME tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch but faded early. RED HILLS was urged to dispute the pace inside foes racing into the backstretch, continued to press the issue inside foes under pressure to the far turn and soon gave way. INDYGO PRINCE was never a factor.
