MAC'S RULE dueled for the lead into the stretch and edged away under pressure. MILLIONS off a step slow, chased the pace, angled three wide on the turn and closed to be up for the place. HANGIN IN THERE dueled for the lead along the inside into the stretch and weakened. DAVEY'S CUTLASS rated in striking position, raced three wide around the turn and had no response in the drive. BIRDSHOT saved ground and lacked a rally. GOLD CURE was always outrun. TIMELY CHANGE was no factor after breaking a step slow.
