NASTY TOUR showed speed along the inside, then drew off through the stretch under a strong hand ride. MOUNT MCKINLEY well placed along the inside, gained the place while no match for the winner. SUPER BOWL unhurried after hitting the gate at the start, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. LINE TOPPER chased the pace three wide, made a run at the leader approaching the quarter pole, then tired in the drive. TEN KARAT GOLD steadied approaching the end of the backstretch, raced three wide around the turn and faltered. STEVIE BUBBLES was never a factor. DAVID IN PLACE was always outrun. ROSZELL MACK showed speed into the turn and faded.
