VESPERS outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and rallied under pressure to be up late. LA CAT unhurried after breaking slowly, rallied four wide on the far turn and closed to be up for the place while unable to match strides with the winner late. HERZBLATT rated off the pace, angled three wide on the far turn, moved to take over in the stretch and opened a clear lead but was outfinished. TUFF CHICK allowed to settle, closed with a mild response. MISS ANNIE BEA chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead leaving the far turn, then weakened in the drive. ENTER chased the leaders three wide into the far turn and tired. MARILYN MERLOT sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace into the far turn and faltered. VANGELIA steadied soon after the start, raced in striking position and faded. SARAH SAYS GO was through early.
