QUEST outrun early, rallied four wide on the turn to take over at the top of the stretch, then drew clear. HARBOR STAR off slowly, chased the pace four wide around the turn, then lugged in early stretch and closed to proved second best. ZIGEUNER chased the pace, then was checked and angled out for room in early stretch and closed to gain the show. THUNDERSTORM unhurried after breaking slowly, steadied in traffic on the backstretch and again on the turn, then failed to threaten. BRUSH BY saved ground and was not a factor. BERT'S NICKY pressed the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. NANY'S FORUM showed speed off the rail, then his rider lost his whip leaving the turn and faded.
