SCORPIUS showed speed along the rail, then increased his margin through the stretch under pressure. HUNTING unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and rallied to gain the place. GRAND CHAMPION off slowly, was outrun early, raced four wide around the turn and rallied to be up for the show. PIZZI'S PRIDE rated off the pace, raced four wide around the turn and passed tired rivals. HEDGE FUND tracked the pace along the rail after breaking slowly, was boxed in around the turn, moved up to reach the attending position in the stretch, then gave way. PAY IN KIND off slowly, chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. BIG THINGS chased the pace four wide around the turn, then was faltering when steadied in traffic nearing the sixteenth pole. SENOR ROMEO pressed the pace outside SCORPIUS into the stretch, then faded. A GIANT VALENTINE was not a factor. EL APACHE was outrun while saving ground. POR SUPUESTO was done early.
