TRAVELIN MAN was knocked into THANK U PHILIPPE at the start, moved up quickly to chase the pace three wide, rallied to take over nearing the quarter pole, then was fully extended to prevail. GOLDEN MOKA chased the pace off the rail, moved to gain a slim lead on the turn, was outmoved by TRAVELIN MAN racing into the stretch but continued on gamely for the place. THANK U PHILIPPE unhurried after being bumped soundly at the start, swung out for the stretch run and rallied for the show. GOURMET DINNER bumped TRAVELIN MAN at the start, tracked the pace along the inside, swung to the outside approaching the quarter pole and had no late response. RIBO BOBO showed speed along the inside to midway of the turn, then tired. PEACE AT DAWN rated off the pace, steadied from close quarters on the turn and faltered. TRUE HEAVEN tracked the pace four wide into the turn and faded.
