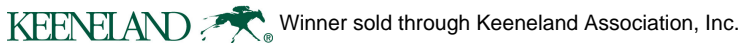

**Footnotes**

CANADIAN MISTRESS set the pace off the rail, came in impeding SALARY DRIVE nearing the quarter pole, then drew clear through the stretch under urging. SEA LEVEL DRIVE rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn to reach CANADIAN MISTRESS racing into the stretch but couldn't stay with that rival while clearly best of the others. SALARY DRIVE stalked the pace along the rail, checked from inside CANADIAN MISTRESS approaching the quarter pole and failed to recover. EXCHANGE FUNDS chased the pace to into the turn, then was tiring when checked in behind SALARY DRIVE on the turn. SLEEPLESS DIXIE chased the pace three wide, made a run at the winner racing into the turn, then faltered. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY AND A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF SALARY DRIVE, CANADIAN MISTRESS WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED THIRD.
