STAKES Gulfstream Park Turf H. Grade 1 - Thoroughbred
 FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. (\$15,000 bonus for FTBOA Registered Florida-Bred by an FTBOA Registered Florida Sire). By subscription of \$300 each by Saturday, January 25, 2014, which shall accompany the nomination, \$3,000 to pass the entry box and \$1,500 additional to start, with \$300,000 Guaranteed. All fees shall be paid before the start of the race. The owner of the winner to receive \$180,000, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$9,000 to fifth and \$6,000 to sixth. In the event this stakes is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Trophy to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 25, 2014 with 19 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth) (Rail at 96 feet).

Footnotes

LOCHTE broke readily to gain a forward placing along the inside, was rated just off the pacesetter inside foes while maintaining striking distance racing into the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn while briefly awaiting an opening, was urged to challenge inside the leader when presented an opening in upper stretch, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and surged clear late under strong handling. IMAGINING was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, steadily advanced to contention while shifting out five wide on the far turn, steadily moved to challenge for command in that path while shifting inwards under pressure racing into upper stretch but couldn't match the winner's kick while prevailing for the place honors. AMIRA'S PRINCE (IRE) came through close quarters after bobbling slightly at the break, pulled his way to terms to a position just off the pacesetter stalking that foe under firm reserve racing into the backstretch, continued under patient handling into the second bend, was prompted to challenge between rivals nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. TETRADRACHM moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break to dictate the pace on a comfortable margin, continued in that fashion into the far turn but weakened once headed leaving the furlong marker. NIKKI'S SANDCASTLE settled in the last flight along the inside racing to the backstretch, gradually drew into contention shifting off the inside nearing upper stretch, angled out five wide in the last furlong but continued with interest to make some mild progress late. CHARMING KITTEN gained a position just off the second flight while steadying a bit in close quarters racing into the backstretch, continued in that position into the far turn, shifted out while being urged through close quarters to challenge between foes racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. SUMMER FRONT tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance four wide racing into the far turn, was caught in tight quarters between foes in that path nearing upper stretch and proved empty in the drive. BOISTEROUS was prompted to gain a position three deep in the second flight tracking the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, lodged a brief bid in that path between foes on the far turn but soon emptied out.
