Footnotes

LEA, urged along four wide in the opening furlong to gain terms with the pacesetter, shifted nearer to the inside joining that foe prompting the issue racing into the backstretch, steadily increased the pressure racing into the second bend between foes to gain a narrow advantage, forged clear while shifting well off the inside leaving the far turn, maintained a clear margin to the end under strong handling and was taken in hand approaching the wire once the issue was decided while setting a new course record. WILL TAKE CHARGE was prompted to gain a contending position inside foes tracking just off the leaders racing along the rail racing into the backstretch, shifted out nearing the far turn, was urged to advance splitting foes four deep racing into the second bend, then continued with a solid late response to close the gap on the winner late. VIRAMUNDO settled off the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily advanced to contention inside foes racing into the far turn, saved ground on the second bend steadily gaining position, then shifted out in upper stretch but couldn't menace the top pair through the last furlong. BOURBON COURAGE, caught five wide in the opening stages while being urged to gain terms with the first flight, shifted inwards on the first turn to race three deep tracking just off the first flight, continued with a steady bid three deep between foes into the second bend and gave way after six furlongs. UNCAPTURED was hustled to secure the lead inside foes racing into the first turn, dueled for command along the rail through the backstretch and gave way abruptly racing into the second bend. NECK 'N NECK gained a position between foes in the second flight racing to the first turn, was steadied avoiding traffic entering the backstretch, was urged to advance inside foes racing into the second bend gaining some position, shifted out five wide racing through the stretch and had no further response. REVOLUTIONARY broke a bit slowly, was settled into stride along the inside, shifted outside foes racing through the backstretch while being prompted to advance, was caught six wide racing into

the far turn and couldn't menace further. JOSHUA'S COMPRISE broke slowly, was carried wide into the first turn by MACHO BULL and proved no threat. MACHO BULL settled into stride racing four wide into the first turn, shifted to the inside nearing the backstretch but never gained contention. RIVER SEVEN broke out bumping ROMANSH, tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight while under some prompting racing into the first turn, shifted out four deep on the backstretch while being urged to lodge an early challenge after a half but quickly came up empty racing into the far turn. ROMANSH, bumped at the start, was righted while shifting out four wide racing into the first turn and coming under prompting to advance, was fanned five wide on the backstretch while briefly gaining striking distance after a half but soon proved empty.
