**Footnotes**

SAGAMORE showed speed along the inside, increased his advantage leaving the turn and into the stretch while coming off the rail, then was fully extended to hold off GEORGE'S DANCE. The latter, tracked the pace four wide around the turn and was gaining on the winner at the finish. MEDITERRANEAN SEA chased the winner into the stretch and gave way. B L'S RED SOCK bumped with JACOB J at the start, then was checked from close quarters leaving the backstretch and failed to menace. DIXIE REBEL chased pace three wide around the turn and tired. RENO'S IMAGE well placed in behind the leaders, raced three wide on the turn and faltered. JACOB J was outrun after being steadied when he bumped with B L'S RED SOCK at the start.
