DREAM RUSH hustled to get the lead after breaking a step slowly, set the pace along the inside, repulsed a bid from DREAMING OF ANNA midway of the turn and drew clear under urging. YOU ASKED unhurried early, raced three wide around the turn and closed well to prove second best. DREAMING OF ANNA chased the pace after stumbling at the start, made a run to reach the winner midway of the turn but couldn't stay with that rival and tired in the drive. SPLENDID IN SPRING rated off the pace, saved ground around the turn and faltered. SECRETSOFTHEHEART reserved off the pace, faded leaving the turn. BEAR NOW off slowly, was outrun.
