QUIET QUEEN stalked the pace, angled to the rail for racing room on the turn, slipped through inside SURPRISEINTHEBOX to reach even terms for command leaving the turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and prevailed. SURPRISEINTHEBOX set the pace under pressure racing off the rail, responded when challenged by QUIET QUEEN entering the stretch, then dueled with that rival and continued on gamely while being edged to the wire in the closing strides. JULIE'S TWIN CHARM reserved early, advanced into contention four wide around the turn, was outmoved in the stretch, then finished willingly and was getting to the top ones late. HOUSE QUEST chased the pace three wide, made a run to try SURPRISEINTHEBOX on the turn, then tired. KETTLE RUN was through after six furlongs. GO CHELY GO pressed the pace along the rail into the turn, then faded.
