OMEGA GIRL showed speed off the rail, drew clear in the stretch, then was fully extended to last over TEMPEST STORM. The latter, chased the pace three wide, was outmoved by the winner in the stretch, then came back on under pressure and rallied to just miss. SHIFT IT chased the leaders along the rail into the stretch and weakened. MOTION MISS well placed into the stretch, lacked a late response. ALL DRAMA failed to menace after being outrun early. VERSE CHOIR reserved after she lost her footing at the start when the ground appeared to break away from her, advanced four wide around the turn to loom a threat racing into the stretch, then tired. CERVEZA stumbled badly at the start and was not a factor. A GLASS OF WATER showed little.
