WITCHESOFWESTFIELD chased the pace along the inside, steadied on the turn, recovered and continued to chase the leader into the stretch, eased out, then rallied to be just up at the wire. TWENTYONEANDTWO showed speed while angling over to the rail, made the pace into the stretch, increased her advantage nearing the eighth pole, then just failed to last. TRES LECHES reserved early, rallied along the inside to be up for the show, then was steadied to avoid running up on TWENTYONEANDTWO in the final strides. SHANDA D chased the pace into the stretch and continued on with good courage while being outfinished. QEYAADA outrun after bumping with LOLA B. at the start, closed well late. BY LAND OR BY SEA chased the pace three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. SIMPLY IMPRESSIVE reserved off the pace, saved ground and closed with a mild rally. ALLABOUTIMAGE (NZ) was tracking the leaders along the inside when steadied in behind WITCHESOFWESTFIELD on the turn and failed to menace. LOLA B. was no factor after stumbling at the start and being bumped between rivals. ANGEL'S COVE was outrun. WILD WIT rated off the pace after bumping with LOLA B. at the start, steadied in traffic on the turn and tired. YOLANDA'S DREAM raced four wide and faltered.
