BANDERIA (ARG) steadied in behind the leaders racing into the far turn, followed SAN DARE through along the rail, came outside that rival to take over leaving the turn and drew clear under pressure. SAN DARE rated off the pace, slipped through along the rail to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then was no match for the winner. SPEND A BUCK BABY unhurried early, passed tired rivals for the show. GRANDSTONE stalked the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and tired. LIGHT WAVE vied for the lead, came off the rail entering the far turn, then faltered in the drive. ICANSEECLEARLY vied for the lead outside LIGHT WAVE, raced three wide on the far turn and faded.
