BOANA (GER) steadied to avoid running up on rivals entering the first turn, rallied along the rail on the far turn to gain the lead at the top of the stretch and drew away. MISS HELLIE unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the place while never a threat to the winner. MAGIC PEAK stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. BIJOU reserved early, raced three wide on the far turn and had no late response. LADY LIBERTY chased the pace into the stretch and faltered. ALPHA SAPHIRE set the pace along the inside, came off the rail entering the stretch and gave way. E MAIL PAT raced in striking position into the far turn and faded.
